12:15 0.0mi
Depart from Bentley Wildfowl and Motor Museum



12:18 1.7mi
At the end of the road **turn left** onto The Broyle (B2192)



12:20 3.2mi
Turn right onto Shortgate Lane (After the Wok Inn signed for Laughton and Ripe)



12:22 4.6mi
Carry on over cross road



12:21 5.7mi
Turn right onto Mill Lane (Signed for Ripe)



12:27 7.6mi
Turn right at cross roads



12:31 9.4mi
At the end of the road **turn left** onto the A27



12:32 10.2mi
Turn left into Middle Farm

13:15 Depart from **Middle Farm** Turning left onto the A27

We plan on staying at Middle Farm for around **45 minutes**, there is a tea room for those of us that want to grab a drink and maybe a nibble.

There is farm shop giving people the opportunity to buy some local produce such as cheese, preserves and tea etc.

There is also a Cider and Perry shop in which you are able to try out the award winning beverages before you purchase.

Turn left onto Lullington Road
(across a small bridge)



13:24 13.8mi
Turn right at white signpost following the main Lullington Road



13:26 14.4mi
At the end of the road **turn right** onto Chapel Hill ->The Street



13:29 16.3mi
Follow the road round to the right onto Litlington Road
Keep a look out on your right for the Litlington White Horse Carved into the Downs



13:32 16.7mi
At the end of the road, emerging at the picturesque seven sisters country park, **turn left** onto the coastal A259 East Dean Road



13:40 20.8mi
Turn right onto Warren Road
(following brown signposts for Seafrent and Beachy Head)



13:43 21.7mi
Turn right onto Beachy Head Road
(following the brown signpost for Beachy Head)



13:45 22.5mi
Arrive at **The Beachy Head Pub**.
Turing right into the car park

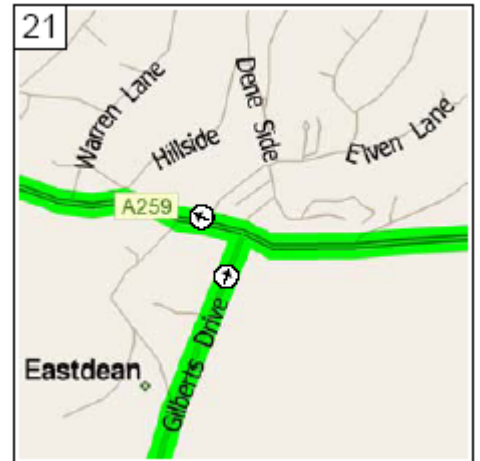
We intend to stay at **The Beachy Head** for food for about an **hour and a half**.

After Driving through Seaford town at the roundabout opposite the train station take the **first exit** onto Blatchington Road -> Dane Road



16:20 32.2mi
At the end of the road **turn right** onto marine parade.



16:20 32.7mi

- At the end of the road take the first exit at the roundabout onto the A27
- At the next Roundabout take the second exit right back onto the A26
- After driving through the Culfail Tunnel Take the second exit right onto the A26. (OR turn left to enter Lewes)
